Notice of Race

The event will be hosted by Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club (CBYC). Club and Event information are available at www.cbyc.org.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 Individual Classes will be governed as defined below. In the event of a conflict, individual Class Rules shall apply.

- 1.3 The Organizing Authority (OA) is CBYC.
- 1.4 In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SI), the SI shall prevail. **This changes RRS 63.7.**
- 1.5 Individual classes shall be responsible for administering any procedures or documents required by Class Rules.
- 1.6 **US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are NOT in effect.**
- 1.7 OA reserves the right to amend this NOR and to post updated NOR at www.cbyc.org.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry in this regatta is open to all boats that are in compliance and good standing with the West Coast Farr 40 Fleet
- 2.2 Each boat must be entered by an individual who is a member of a yacht club or sailing association that is a Member of US Sailing (or National Authority).
- 2.3 Entries shall be submitted to the CBYC office by phone, (310-519-1694) or Email, (office@cbyc.org). Payment can be made by check or credit card by calling the CBYC front desk. CBYC entry forms can be found on line at http://www.cbyc.org/race/entry_gnrl07.pdf or in the CBYC office.
- 2.4 Weigh in will be Friday, September 6, 2013 from 4-6 PM and Saturday September 7, 2013 from 8-10 AM.

3. FEES

The entry fee is \$200.00 USD for the Farr 40 Class for entries received before September 2, 2013 and \$250 USD thereafter.

4. SCHEDULE

1300hrs: Warning Signal Race 4
ASAP Warning Signal Race 5
1700hrs: Post Race Reception and awards at CBYC.

No Race Shall Be Started after 1600 Hours on September 8th

The Race Committee (RC) at its discretion may run fewer races on Saturday or more races on Sunday or less than the five (5) scheduled races based on wind and weather conditions.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available on August 26, 2013, at CBYC and at www.cbyc.org.

6. RACING AREA

The racing area will be in the Pacific Ocean, approximately (3/4) mile at 220 degrees from Angels Gate.

7. COURSES

Courses shall be windward/leeward with leeward gates per the SI

8. SCORING

8.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply except that all scores will count. **This changes Rule A2.**

8.2 Five (5) races are scheduled. Two (2) races must be completed to constitute a regatta

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

The RC shall communicate information on channel 73 and make every effort to broadcast course and OCS information to boats on the water.

10. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place boats.

11. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be permitted, subject to any provisions of individual Class Rules.
